**If you're a Los Angeles-area high school student scheduled to graduate in 2012,
you're eligible to apply for this Scholarship.**



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- High School Senior graduating in May or June of 2012.
- Lives within commuting distance of Columbia College Hollywood.
- High School cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- U.S. citizen or legal resident.
- FASFA application on file with Financial Aid Office showing a maximum EFC = 2,000.
- Prior attendance at a Columbia College Hollywood Experience Day (Open House) with your Parent or Guardian.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- A completed and signed scholarship application with stamped documentation on the application of your attendance at a Columbia College Hollywood Experience Day with your Parent or Guardian.
- Submission of a video project you have directed or script you have written. Editors and cinematographers should submit a 3-5 minute edited compilation of prior work.
- Letter of Recommendation from two academic sources, one of which should be from your high school video production teacher or teacher in a similar field.
- Official transcript of your academic record in High School.
- Personal essay. A two-page, typed essay that discusses your past experiences and future goals in the filmmaking field. Be sure to comment on your aspirations and how those aspirations will influence the images you create on the screen.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Financial need.
- Quality of Film project, Script or Reel submitted.
- Participation in activities, internships and work experiences related to the field of television production.
- Honors, awards and acknowledgments related to your past cinematic, academic or extracurricular activities.
- All finalists will be interviewed.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

- Awards are renewable for four consecutive years provided the student maintains a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Students must begin their studies at CCH between July and September 2012.
